Mission Challenge/SAR

Materials Needed:

- 3 Mission Cards Grassland Guardians, Mountain & Island, Arctic Patrol
- Dry Erase Marker
- · Cloth to wipe off cards at end
- Map

Introduction:

- In this challenge, each group will get a different mission card. They will all be going to the same animals, but the questions will be different. They need to completely fill out their card.
- Tell them: You are a biologist studying different species. You need to document their IUCN status and gather information on each animal as to whether it is a predator/prey; what threats it is facing or has faced; where it is found (country/continent, etc); what habitat type it is found in; some of their defenses; their adaptations or what might dictate their survival. MOST of the information will be found on the signs at the animal enclosures, however, some may require the students to THINK and come up with the best possible answer.
- LEADERS/TEACHER: HAS THE ANSWER CARD FOR EACH GROUP

Mission:


Give each group of students a mission card (there are three different ones). Each group has a leader who writes in the answers on their card (we've made multiple cards if you want to keep your groups smaller). Divide your class into the three groups and give each group a mission card ensuring each group gets a different one.

WITHIN EACH GROUP, you can hand out the same mission card if you want to keep the groups smaller. FOR EXAMPLE: divide your class into 3 groups (let's say there are 8 in each group). Group A is the Mission: Grasslands Guardians. Group A can be divided into pairs and each pair gets a Grassland Guardian card & dry erase marker. You can do this with Group B and Group C as well. If Group A prefers to just use 1 Grassland Guardian card for all 8 students, that is OK too!

First Group back with a full card wins the mission challenge. NOTE: they are NOT allowed to RUN in the Zoo, so this is a WALKING CHALLENGE.

Debrief (5 minutes): This is just for discussion. Answers not provided as they may vary.

- Which animal do you think has the most challenges to overcome?
- Is there anything that people can do to overcome some threats?
- What would you say is the main threat to species survival?
- What was the most common IUCN status for the species on your cards? Is this a good sign?
